## **Motivation**

The Babeş-Bolyai University of Cluj-Napoca has awarded the Doctor Honoris Causa degree, the highest university distinction, to Professor Anca Vasiliu, Paris IV Sorbonne University, Centre Nationale de la Recherche Scientifique in Paris, for her excellent achievements in the study of philosophy, theology, and art history, for the outstandingly thorough research and development of ideas on the image, the diaphanous and the Platonic tradition, as well as the lengthy and excellent collaboration with our university.

The ceremony was held on October 12, 2023. Professor Anca Vasiliu's lecture, titled "Is there still something beyond what is? Platonic Perspectives on the Topography of Being", delved into the importance of entities that surpass mere existence and the notion of "beyond". She explored this concept by highlighting some of Plato's philosophical insights on the range of dualities, connections, and shifts between the entity itself and the spatial context where it resides.
