The Babeş-Bolyai University of Cluj-Napoca has awarded the Doctor Honoris Causa title to Professor Bogusław Buszewski, Prof. Jan Czochralski Kuyavian-Pomeranian Research and Development Centre and the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, Poland, for his outstanding scholarly achievements in the field of modern analytical chemistry, particularly in separation sciences, for his national and international prestige, as well as for his significant contributions to the development of external collaborations and to raising the international visibility of the academic community of the Raluca Ripan Institute for Research in Chemistry at Babeş-Bolyai University.

The awarding ceremony took place on June 27, 2024. During this ceremony, Professor Bogusław Buszewski gave an extended presentation entitled *Expectations and challenges of modern analytical chemistry*, in which he expanded on the concept of chemistry in general, the many strategies and methods employed in the contemporary scientific process, the purpose of analytical studies, and the uses and applications of the results of such studies in his field of expertise.
